12:30 – 1:30 SESSION THREE

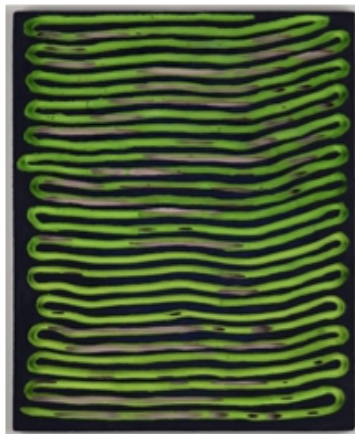
- Heather Eiden
