SHOW PROSPECTUS

Show Dates	Saturday, October 21 – Saturday, November 18 <i>Sunday, November 19: Closing Potluck Brunch and Awards Event</i>
Eligibility	Current MATA Members Membership dues may accompany show entry fees.
Entry Number	Members may enter two pieces. All work entered, that meets show criteria, will be included in the show.
Media	All media accepted
Theme	Small Work / Landscape Artists are required to work within the specified size limitations and to reflect a landscape theme. <i>Artists may interpret the theme as literal or conceptual as their inclinations lead them.</i>
Size Limits	2D work: Finished size (frame included) not to exceed 100 square inches <i>I.E. 10"x10" or 20"x5" or 25"x4" etc.</i> 3D work: Finished size (base included) not to exceed 100 cubic inches <i>I.E. 10"x10"x1" or 10"x5"x2" or 4"x5"x5" or 25"x2"x2" etc.</i> Artists are encouraged to embrace the spirit of the show by working smaller than they usually work. There are no minimum size limitations!
Calendar	Friday, October 6 – Entry form deadline <i>Forms, with presentation requirements, will be distributed in early September</i> Saturday, October 21 – Entries delivered to Carroll University Show opens to the public after AM hanging <i>(Special arrangements for an earlier delivery are possible)</i> Saturday, November 18 – Show officially closes Sunday, November 19 – Member's Social/Potluck Brunch and Awards Event <i>All members are invited to participate</i> Showing members are asked to take work home after the awards presentation <i>(Special arrangements for an alternative pickup time are possible)</i>
